

Introduction

This notice supplements the Environmental Safety Case (ESC) Implementation letter issued to Customer Representatives in December 2013 regarding the updated Waste Acceptance Criteria for LLW Disposal (WAC), Waste Characterisation form (WCH), and Waste Consignment Information form (WCI) for LLW disposal and supercompaction; following incorporation of the comments from earlier consultation exercises.

Implementation***Waste Acceptance Criteria for LLW Disposal (WAC)***

WAC version 4.0 is now available for download from the LLWR website. From 1st April 2014 all consignments of waste for LLW disposal must be compliant with Waste Acceptance Criteria for LLW Disposal - WSC-WAC-LOW version 4.0 unless an approved Waste Consignment Variation (WCV) is in place.

Waste Characterisation Form (WCH)

WCH version 3.2 will be available for download and use from the LLWR website by 3rd February 2014. LLWR would like Customers to use this form with immediate effect. For any Customers who have started working on version 3.1 of the form, LLWR will accept this version until 28th March 2014. During 2014 we expect to have to update the information supplied on approved live waste characterisation documents in line with the data requirements of the new WCH. We are currently considering how best to achieve this.

Waste Consignment Information Form - LLW Disposal and Supercompactable Waste (WCI)

WCI version 3.3 will be available for download and use from the LLWR website by 3rd March 2014. LLWR would like Customers to use this form with immediate effect. For any Customers who have already started working on version 3.2 of the form, LLWR will accept this version until 28th March 2014. These changes do not affect waste being sent for treatment or the Waste Consignment Variation form. The purpose of the new forms is to gather the data we need on wastestreams and individual consignments to undertake our assessments against the assumptions and outcomes of the 2011 ESC and the Waste Acceptance Criteria which were derived from the safety case.

We appreciate the comments and feedback you gave us during the consultation earlier this year; they have been incorporated into the documents where appropriate. Wastestream Capacity

Until LLWR receives its disposal permit we have to operate the annual capacity system alongside a system that will allocate capacity by wastestream. You will be allocated a capacity by wastestream in accordance with WCH documents you have already submitted. Once the disposal permit is received we hope that the annual capacity system will be withdrawn.
