

Introduction

This Notice is to inform customers that the new edition of the IAEA Regulations (SSR-6) must be adopted as of 1st July 2015. In addition, the TC09 (2910B half-height ISO) Licence is due to expire at the end of this month and will not be renewed.

Implementation of SSR-6

As of January 2015, a new set of transport regulations (IAEA SSR-6, 2012 Edition) has been adopted by the UK Competent Authority (CA). This replaces the previous edition, TS-R-1. The deadline for incorporating the requirements of the new regulations and replacing references to TS-R-1 is 1st July 2015.

The Certificates of Approval for all LLWR licenced packages are in the process of being updated to reflect the change from TS-R-1 to SSR-6. These Certificates will be reissued on the LLWR website in advance of the 1st July 2015 deadline. As a result, there will be no interruption to the Licence cover, and no customer action is required.

TC09 Licence Expiration

The TC09 Licence will expire on 30th June 2015 and is not being renewed, as previously communicated via Customer Notice and the LLWR Customer Forums. Please be aware that once the Licence has expired it will not be possible to ship any TC09 containers. Any customers wishing to transport TC09 containers must arrange for the shipment to be completed prior to 30th June 2015.
