

LLWR Package Licencing Update

Introduction

This notice is to inform customers of updates to LLWR IP-2 licenced package licences and licensing system.

Packaging Web Page

The packaging page on the customer portal of the LLWR website has been updated. It has now been formatted to align with the pricing list for package supply and hire and can be found at: http://llwrsite.com/customer-portal/packaging/

TC01 and TC03 Licence Update

The licence for the TC01 IP-2 half height and TC03 IP-2 third height ISO containers have been extended by 8 months. This short extension is to allow for completion of the design modifications to the lid which will also introduce a new IP-2 ISO container reusable variant TC01R.

Customers are reminded, if seeking to reuse the TC01 or TC03 IP-2 ISO containers under the restricted reuse scheme, to comply with the procedure in the Packing and Handling instructions. This ensures the container is registered for reuse and is monitored accordingly.

TC03 Overlid Supply Update

Further to customer communication LLWR-CN-2015-0006, LLWR can confirm there is now a strategic stock of TC03 overlid's available for customer purchase at £1,500 per overlid exclusive of transport.

TC14 and TC19 Licence Update

The TC14 and TC19 IP-2 Drum Licences have both been extended by 3 months only. This short extension is to allow completion of the design review and up issue of the drum Package Design Safety Report, which will potentially expand the permitted contents of the TC14 drum.

TC02 Licence Update

The existing TC02 IP-2 licence (Issue 5) has been revoked and a new licence prepared and issued valid for 2 years to implement changes to the Package Design Safety Report which attaches the S2 (full size) and S3 (half size) stillages to the package design.

TC06 Licence Update

The TC06 (2968) two third height IP-2 ISO container design is currently under licencing review. LLWR requests information regarding forecast supply requirements, and where customers are custodians of loaded or unloaded TC06 IP-2 ISO containers they inform LLWR with forecasted shipment dates. This information is required to align the licencing programme to customer demand.

General Licencing Update

The TC01, TC03, TC14, TC19 IP-2 licence extensions and the TC02 IP-2 licence renewal have been updated to incorporate changes from the implementation of IAEA SSR-6 which is invoked from 01/07/15 and supersedes IAEA TS-R-1.

The TC12 will be updated against SSR-6 on its forthcoming design review which will be within the next 18 months.
