

Introduction

The purpose of this notice is to inform customers that LLWR has received notification from the Environment Agency that they have approved our application for a revised Environmental Permit, effective from 1st November 2015. Furthermore, LLWR has also submitted a revised shorter-term planning application to Cumbria County Council, the outcome of which should be determined in February/March 2016.

What this means

The new Environmental Permit means that waste currently 'stored' in Vault 9 is now permitted for disposal following demonstration of compliance with the Environmental Safety Case (ESC) and new Permit. However, it should be noted that disposal in Vault 9 is subject to planning permission being granted. In addition, the new Permit has replaced annual disposal limitations with a lifetime capacity, which allows greater flexibility for making full use of the LLWR's permitted capacity.

LLWR are now working through an implementation plan, which will result in some changes to the current arrangements for consigning waste under the Waste Services Contract. We do not envisage any additional work for customers as a result of the new permit. We therefore intend to issue a supplementary notice to customers in the near future to outline any changes that need to be made and the arrangements for an appropriate period of consultation.
