

Introduction

This customer notice is to inform customers that, further to LLWR-CN-2015-23, the TC14 and TC19 design review is complete and the Certificates of Approval have now been renewed. The new licences are valid from 30th April 2016 through to 30th April 2018 and are available for download from the [Package Guides](#) page on the LLWR website.

Design Review

During 2015/16 both the TC14 and the TC19 were subject to a design review that took into consideration customer feedback, customer scope-extension requests, regulatory changes and learning from experience. As a result, LLWR has been able to make some changes that benefit our customers.

Beneficial Changes

After listening to customer feedback, LLWR have changed the TC14 licence conditions so that TC14 drums can now be used for transporting sludges and wet solids in addition to liquids and solids. Permitting the transport of sludges and wet solids increases the range of useful applications for the TC14 drum.

In addition, the TC14 and TC19 loading guidance has been made more user-friendly:

- the drum loading guidance for the TC14 and TC19 has been clarified to ensure compliance with the surface radiation limits specified in the IAEA Regulations for the Safe Transport of Radioactive Material, SSR-6, Paragraph 617
- the requirement for chemical compatibility of the contents with the TC14 and TC19 drums has been emphasised

Drum Prices

There is no increase to the drum sale prices as a result of the above changes.
