

### Introduction

We would like to thank everyone that contributed to the consultation process that considered the LLWR Disposal Waste Acceptance Criteria (WAC) and associated amendments to the forms incorporated in the LLWR Waste Services Contract. Your comments and engagement with the process are greatly appreciated.

Receipt of the Environmental Permit and planning permission for waste disposal is a significant milestone for the LLWR and UK nuclear industry. In order to comply with the conditions of these documents changes to the WAC and Waste Acceptance Procedure (WAP) forms were necessary.

This notice concludes the consultation and directs the reader to the outcome of the consultation. We would like to acknowledge your support throughout this period and look forward to collaborating with you to implement these changes.

### Waste Acceptance Criteria

Comments and observations raised during the consultation period have been considered and where possible have been incorporated into the WAC. Final consultation with the Environment Agency is complete and the approved [WAC Version 5.0](#) (WAC 5) is being published on the LLWR website simultaneously with the publication of this customer notice.

### Responses to issues and comments raised during the consultation period

Your comments have received due consideration by LLWR and the responses are being published on the [customer consultation page](#) of the LLWR website simultaneously with the publication of this customer notice. WAC Version 5.0 replaces WAC Version 4.0 with immediate effect.

Unfortunately we could not incorporate all the requests, however, the majority of your suggestions and comments have been embraced and incorporated into the WAC and WAP forms. We remain open to dialogue to clarify and improve understanding on elements and implementation of the WAC and WAP forms.

### WAP Forms

The WAP forms have been amended and updated following the consultation process. These forms will be compatible with the Waste Tracking System that LLWR are developing separately. The first tranche of forms that support compliance with LLWR's Environmental Permit are published alongside this notice. The remainder of the WAP forms will be published week commencing 15<sup>th</sup> August 2016.

### Transition timescales

As described in [Customer Notice 2016-04](#) we will continue to accept the current live forms until 1<sup>st</sup> November 2016, thereafter we will only accept submissions on the new version of the forms. Both sets of forms will remain available on the website until 31<sup>st</sup> October 2016 and are clearly identified. The following table identifies which new versions replace the current versions.

We appreciate that the transition will be different for each customer and we would like to engage in discussions and develop suitable plans for the transition with you. We appreciate that there will be a number of issues to be addressed during the transition:

- waste will have been characterised previously, against earlier WAC,
- preparation of some consignments will straddle the timescales above, and
- company systems and procedures will require modifying.
