Training modules

eLearning (duration 35 to 90mins):

Self-directed learning workbooks (duration 90 minutes to 3 hours):

- *Completing the Waste Enquiry Form (WEN) (Issue 3)*
- *Completing the Waste Consignment Information (WCI) Form Diversion Services (Issue 3)*
- *Completing the WCI Form LLW Disposal (Issue 3)*
- *Completing the WCI Form Supercompaction (Issue 3 - due May 2017).*

Classroom modules

- *Waste Loading Plan Training (2.5 days)*
- *Characterisation Overview (2.5 hours) – available to enable customers to deliver training to their own staff.*

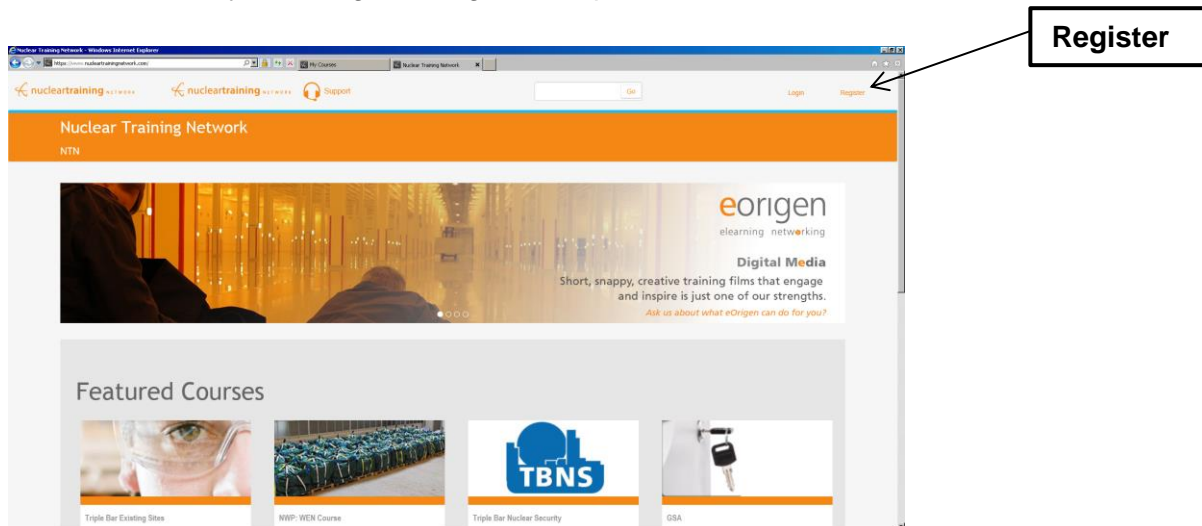
How to access modules

Please contact the National Programme directly regarding classroom modules.

To access, free of charge, NWP eLearning modules and learning workbooks:

1. Start by registering on the NTN portal: <https://www.nucleartrainingnetwork.com/>

The site will walk you through the registration process.



2. Once registered (or when revisiting the site), just type **NWP** into the search box and all the available National Waste Programme courses will appear. Enrol for free on any NWP courses.

We hope you'll find the courses useful and look forward to receiving your evaluation feedback.

If you have any difficulties accessing the NTN, the following may be of assistance:

- the modules have been designed to run on pcs only – they will not work on tablets, macs or mobile phones
- the site uses Pop-ups, for help establishing if you are blocking pop-ups: see <https://www.nucleartrainingnetwork.com/support/>
- once you have turned off Pop-up blockers, if you experience further difficulty viewing the site, you may need to check your operating system and browser are compatible, see: <https://www.nucleartrainingnetwork.com/support/>
- when you are revisiting the site, or a page, if you are unable to access a particular web page, try pressing the Control and F5 keys together to reload the page. This clears your cache, which can be stopping pages refreshing.
