

Introduction

This notice is to inform Customers that National Waste Programme (NWP) training on how to complete LLW Repository Ltd's Waste Consignment Information (WCI) Form for Supercompaction is now available on the Nuclear Training Network (NTN) portal.

Training on completing the WCI Form (Supercompaction)

Following changes to the LLW Repository Ltd waste services forms in 2016, NWP training on how to complete the WCI Form (Supercompaction) is now available.

Training on the Waste Enquiry (WEN) Form, Waste Characterisation (WCH) Form and the WCI Forms for LLW Disposal and Diversion Services is already available.

The method of training delivery on the forms has also changed, from e-learning modules, to the completion of downloadable workbooks. This was in response to Customer feedback and has the benefit of enabling the workbooks to be used as reference guides when Customers are completing forms for their waste.

Learners must return to the NTN portal to take the course on-line assessment and to receive a certificate.

How to access modules

The training module is available free of charge via the NTN portal. If learners haven't already done so, they will need to register at <https://www.nucleartrainingnetwork.com>; then insert 'NWP' in the search box and the new course, all existing NWP training modules will then appear.
